

Americans for Minimal Government (“AMiGo”) Party Principles

101) The purpose of state government is to enhance prosperity and protect people from others doing harm. Government that **stays out** of people's lives, except to protect public safety, is optimal.

The purpose of municipal government may be broader. Citizens who know one another, and are committed to similar purposes, may legislate for their enclave.

201) In all aspects, even those permitted to the government, the wise course is to first consider private work instead of public work.

202) Environmental protection, though worthy, requires Constitutional authorization.

301) The government's armed forces should only be used to defend from attacks and deter attacks to the home land.

302) A military draft is unethical and unnecessary: if our homeland is endanger, there will be ample volunteers.

303) Citizens retaining the right to bear arms, are the best defense against tyranny. No legislation should be drawn to curtail the right of citizens to defend themselves and their communities.

CT Corollaries -- AMiGo officials, if elected, shall not:

701) force some towns to pay for other towns' education.

702) put taxpayers into long-term debt, absent a national or state emergency

703) take the money of working people and give it to lazy people

704) take money from people who have been responsible about health care and give it to adults who have been irresponsible

705) vote to imprison people for victim-less crimes

706) allow frivolous lawsuits, unless there is a penalty for a filing deemed frivolous

707) curtail the right of adults to own and use firearms.
